EMBRACE Mentors are caring, supportive adults who build relationships with youth and enhance the ongoing stability of family, by:

- ▶ Providing support and understanding in a shared life experience
- ▶ Helping develop healthy social relationships
- ▶ Encouraging additional opportunities for fun, adventure and learning
